ORGANIZATION OF THE EVENT

The competition is organized by Bobsleigh CANADA Skeleton.

PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY

The competition will be carried out in accordance with IBSF Para Sport Rules. All athletes must have a valid **IBSF e-license** issued by their National Federation.

It is the responsibility of the National Federation to enter its athletes through the IBSF's online system at <http://ibsf.sportresult.com>. The deadline for submission is five days before (December 12, 2018) the first Team Captain's meeting, taking place on December 17, 2018.

Athletes must have eligible IBSF Classification to compete in IBSF Para Sport events or undergo classification process before the start of the first TCM. New athletes without classification must fill out medical information forms and send to the IBSF Head of Classification, classification@ibsf.org 10 days before first TCM.

Prior to sliding, all athletes, coaches and staff must complete a Winsport track waiver at Guest Services.
