IBSF Executive Committee Elections 2022 Information

Statutes Regulations

- No Member shall have more than one (1) individual elected to the offices of President or any of the Vice Presidents
- Only Members can submit candidates for election to the Executive Committee. Any such candidates must be:
 - Over twenty one (21) years of age; and
 - Possess the citizenship of his/her nominating Member; or be an official resident of that Nation for at least three years prior to the date of the Congress
- No person is eligible for election to the Executive Committee if they have reached the Age Limit as at the date of Congress at which they stand for election or if they will reach the Age Limit within six (6) months thereafter. For these purposes, the "Age Limit" is such age that the IOC has implemented as the age limit for membership of the IOC.

Deadline

Duly signed submissions with a Curriculum Vitae of any candidate have to arrive with Mrs Heike Groesswang, IBSF Secretary General, no later than **May 14th, 2022 (23:59 Lausanne time)**.

Presentation of Candidates

Each candidate for the position of the Vice-President will have the possibility to present himself/herself for 5 minutes during the Congress day whereas candidates for the position of President will have 10 minutes.

Election Process

The IBSF Congress approves the proposed scrutineers who will conduct the election process with the support of the Secretary General.

The election will be held with secret ballots. Each delegate will be called personally and will receive his/her secret ballots. The voting will be done in one or more voting booths.

The voting ballot will be placed in a closed ballot box. After the voting has been concluded the scrutineers will count the votes and the head of scrutineers will inform the Congress accordingly about the result.

Dispute

Any dispute during the election process shall be brought forward immediately but no later than 15 minutes after the result has been announced and handled by the representatives of the IBSF Appeals Tribunal on-site.
