EUROPE AND NORTH AMERICAN CUP 2022/2023

Art. 4.6: All nations may participate and score points with a maximum of 4 teams. The male pilots placed among the top 12 and female pilots placed among the top 8 of the current IBSF discipline ranking will not be admitted either to the Europe Cup races or to the North American Cup races, unless the respective nation uses its entire WC quota.

EUROPE AND NORTH AMERICAN CUP 2022/2023

Art. 4.6: All nations may participate and score points with a maximum of 4 teams. The male pilots placed among the top 12 and female pilots placed among the top 8 of the current IBSF discipline ranking will not be admitted either to the Europe Cup races or to the North American Cup races, unless the respective nation uses its entire WC quota.
