4.2.1 Requirements for participation in the World Championships:

a) Only those pilots can take part who have been participating and ranked in a minimum of 5 IBSF races on at least 3 different tracks in the 24 months prior to the competition. If a pilot has fulfilled this qualification criteria by October 1st of the respective season, it remains valid for the entire current season.

b) In addition the pilot must have been ranked in at least 3 of these 5 races on a minimum of 2 different tracks during the on-going season. Participation in a 2-man/2-woman bobsleigh race only counts for 2-man/2-woman bobsleigh, whilst participation in a 4-man bobsleigh race counts only for 4-man bobsleigh. For the participation in IBSF Women's Monobob races, the participation in IBSF 2-woman bobsleigh races can be used for the calculation of the 5-3-2 rule. Female pilots who fulfill this 5-3-2 rule only due to their participation in IBSF Women's Monobob races may only participate in the Women's Monobob race. The defending Junior World Champion team and the Women's Monobob Junior World Champion respectively are also entitled to participate.

c) The general quota system for the World Championships must be respected.
