IBSF Women's Monobob World Series

1. Season Planning 2020 – 2022

- a. Women's Monobob series conducted during each of the IBSF series (WC/EC/NAC) as a separate series: IBSF Women's Monobob World Series
- b. A max. of five races each will be conducted during each series
- c. Participation quota in 2020/21:
 - i. For Women's Monobob races held during the WC: according to 2-woman bobsleigh quota
 - ii. For Women's Monobob races held during the EC/NAC: according to EC/NAC quota for 2-woman bobsleigh
- d. Participation quota for each series in 2021/22

2. ITP/Test event in Beijing (March 2021)

- a. The quotas for participation in the International Training periods are the same as for the World Cup of the current season
- b. All remaining Nations, which have no quotas for the participation in the World Cup, have the right to participate in the International Trainings periods with one Women's Monobob

3. Training runs

- a. During World Cup week: 6 training runs in total for 2-woman and Women's Monobob – according to point 10.1.2 of our bobsleigh rules
- b. During EC/NAC week: minimum 2 training runs per day for 2-woman or Women's Monobob. To be admitted to the race teams need to have at least two training runs without any accident.

4. Ranking and points

There will be one IBSF Women's Monobob World Series ranking list.

The maximum amount of races to be considered will be five.

The IBSF Women's Monobob Ranking list will be updated immediately after each Women's Monobob race which takes part during the World Cup.

There will be a Women's Monobob Combined ranking list which is composed of 2-woman bobsleigh points and Women's Monobob points. The maximum amount of races for 2-woman bobsleigh to be considered will be the same amount of races taken place in 2-woman bobsleigh World Cup; the maximum amount of races in Women's Monobob to be considered will be five.

a. 2020/21:

- i. The same points as for EC/NAC will be assigned.
- ii. From ranking 11 to 30 the same points will be assigned (68 points)

b. 2021/22:

- i. For Women's Monobob races conducted through the World Cup events the World Cup point list applies
- ii. For Women's Monobob races conducted through the NAC/EC the NAC/EC point list applies

5. Order, delivery, spare parts, maintenance, etc.

The IBSF will send out an order-request-form to the National Federations.

The delivery will start as of 15th of October 2020.

Spare parts will be available directly at the manufacturer iXent. Each Monobob will have a series-number and parts will be marked accordingly.
